OVERVIEW

Hope Clinic serves Garland residents without health insurance coverage and whose income is below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. Charitable clinics like HOPE have become medical homes to many people who would otherwise utilize local Emergency Departments for urgent care needs.

Our focus for those in need of medical treatment is delivery of a Holistic Approach to Quality Patient Care, provided free-of-charge to Garland residents.

Hope Clinic obtained the highest level of recognition from the National Committee for Quality Assurance as a Patient Centered Medical Home – Level III.

- 78% of patients are Latino, primarily women, enduring poverty
- Majority of Hope Patients live in Garland Districts 2, 5, 6, and 8
- Hope Clinic remains the only Garland facility offering free healthcare
